The public judges its government by the way public officials and employees conduct themselves in the posts to which they are appointed. The people have a right to expect that every public official will conduct him or herself in a manner that will preserve public confidence in and respect for the government he/she represents. By accepting the position applied for I agree to:

Subject to due process of law, any official or employee who violates any provision of this article may be disqualified from being an appointed official or an employee of the Municipality for a period of four years commencing with the date on which a determination is made by a court of competent jurisdiction, Council or the Chief Administrator, as the case may be, that a violation has occurred. If the violation occurs while he is serving as an appointed official, he may be removed from his position as an appointed official by an affirmative vote of four Council members. If the violation occurs while he is serving as an employee, he may be removed from his position as an employee by the Chief Administrator.
